1. As a start: watch the video and do the assignments to make sure you have understood the meaning.

3. Watch the video linked above to get an introduction to the person you choose. **N.B. You only watch one of the videos!**
4. Use the internet to find more information about your person and the issue. Try to answer the questions below. Note that some of them are about how you find the information, not only the information itself. Copy the questions below into your own document and share it with your teacher.
